
ANCIENT ROME WREATH

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the strip along the side of this page. Fit it around your head and tape the two ends together. You may need to cut out the second strip as well and attach the two ends together to make the headband bigger.
- 2. Next, cut out the leaves. If you need more leaves, you can print this page twice!
- 3. Glue or tape these to the headband. The pointy end of the leaves should be pointing forwards when you are wearing it.
